

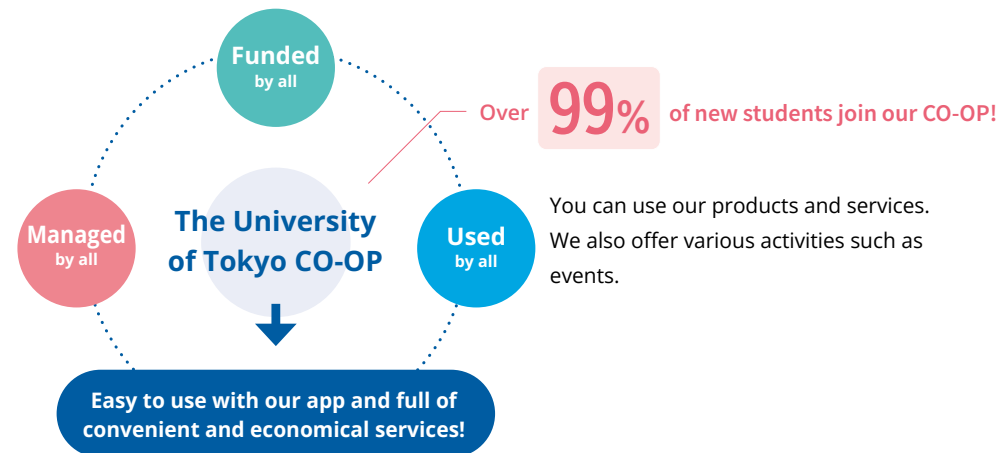
About UTokyo CO-OP

The University of Tokyo CO-OP (UTokyo CO-OP) was founded in 1946. It is an economic and non-profit organization funded by members of the University of Tokyo, including students, faculty, staff, and other related parties. Our goal is to enhance the cultural and economic aspects of our members' lives. We operate the campus cafeterias and shops, and engage in a variety of projects and activities to support students.

How UTokyo CO-OP Works

By paying the contribution and joining the CO-OP, each member becomes a co-owner of the CO-OP.

We have various projects based on our members' voices. Our representatives, the valedictorians and the trustees, manage them.



Our 8 Mid-Term Management Plans

- 5 We will establish a housing business with our members' perspectives in mind.
- 6 We will address the University of Tokyo's Digital Transformation (DX).
- 7 We will execute sound business operations and investments.
- 8 We continue to operate the Central Cafeteria and Komaba Communication Plaza on consignment.

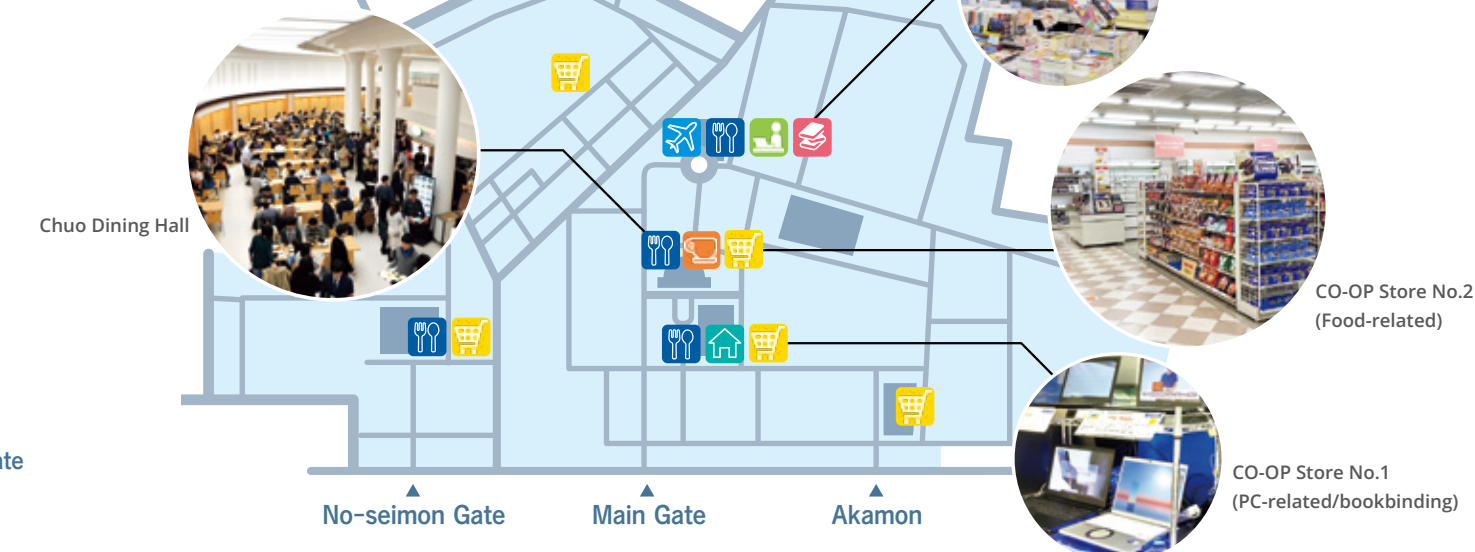

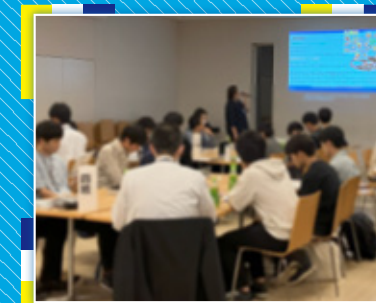

Athletic Foundation of the University of Tokyo

Direct Connection to Production Areas (Sanchoku)

In CO-Operation with producer, production areas and other CO-Operatives, we are promoting "Direct Connection to Production Areas" activities that create face-to-face relationships between people. We are involved in the "Fukushima Sanchoku Fair" as an initiative to consider and support the recovery of the agriculture, forestry, and fishery industries in Fukushima.

The Sake Festival is a project in which UTokyo CO-OP serves as a place of recreation and relaxation for the community of our university members, and aims to deepen exchanges between people.



For Sustainable Society

We collaborate with student organizations and organizations inside and outside the university that aim to create a sustainable university and society. As part of our Sustainability Week, we are promoting initiatives aimed at reducing our environmental impact through food.



Secondhand Books Fair

Used books are collected from students, faculty and staff in advance and sold at school festivals. The profits are donated to UNICEF and the University CO-OP Tasukeai Scholarship System. This historic event has been conducted by the students' committee for more than 40 years.

Many international students come to UTokyo campuses for studying. In order to cater to the university community which is internationalizing and diversifying, we offer vegan and halal food with cafeteria menus.

Eligible to be a CO-OP member

Students, graduate students, faculty and staff of the University of Tokyo; Those who work at a facility in the University of Tokyo campus; Those who have an address in Tokyo or Kashiwa City, Chiba Prefecture.

For online application

- 1 Enter your information including your name and address.
- 2 Please pay 24,000 yen for deposit (60 shares) at a convenience store.
- 3 After confirming your payment, we will register you as a member.
- 4 After completing the registration, you will receive an email with information about the digital membership card found on our app.
